

They may provide leadership and guidance to others and have limited responsibility for the output of others.

The job roles that relate to this qualification may include ensemble dancer, dancer, or choreographer.

PATHWAY TO SUCCESS.

Students will participate in two major performances per year: Mid-Year showcase, and End of Year performance.

Mid-Year Showcase

The mid-year showcase is a professional performance opportunity for all students, conducted in a theatre. The demonstration may include; choreographed works learned in class, self-choreographed pieces, pieces choreographed by other students, as well as video footage of works.

The showcase pieces will be selected at the discretion of the Artistic Directors, with even distribution of performance opportunities for students.

End-of-year Showcase

The end-of-year showcase is a professional performance opportunity for all students, conducted in a theatre. Students will learn stagecraft, lighting specs, staging, theatre craft & and etiquette, performance language, costuming requirements, as well as hair/makeup specs in the lead-up to the performance.

All performances will be choreographed by Scimm. Dance faculty and guest choreographers.

Students understand the volume of participation in these numbers is at the discretion of the Artistic Directors.

Students will be offered additional in-house performance and choreographic opportunities throughout their course.

Graduation

A Graduation ceremony event will be held at the conclusion of the course (likely in December, please refer to important dates for up-to-date information). The graduation ceremony will be an opportunity for friends and family to celebrate the achievements of the student's year, including obtaining a tertiary certificate and completing Scimm. Dance Pre-Professional course.


